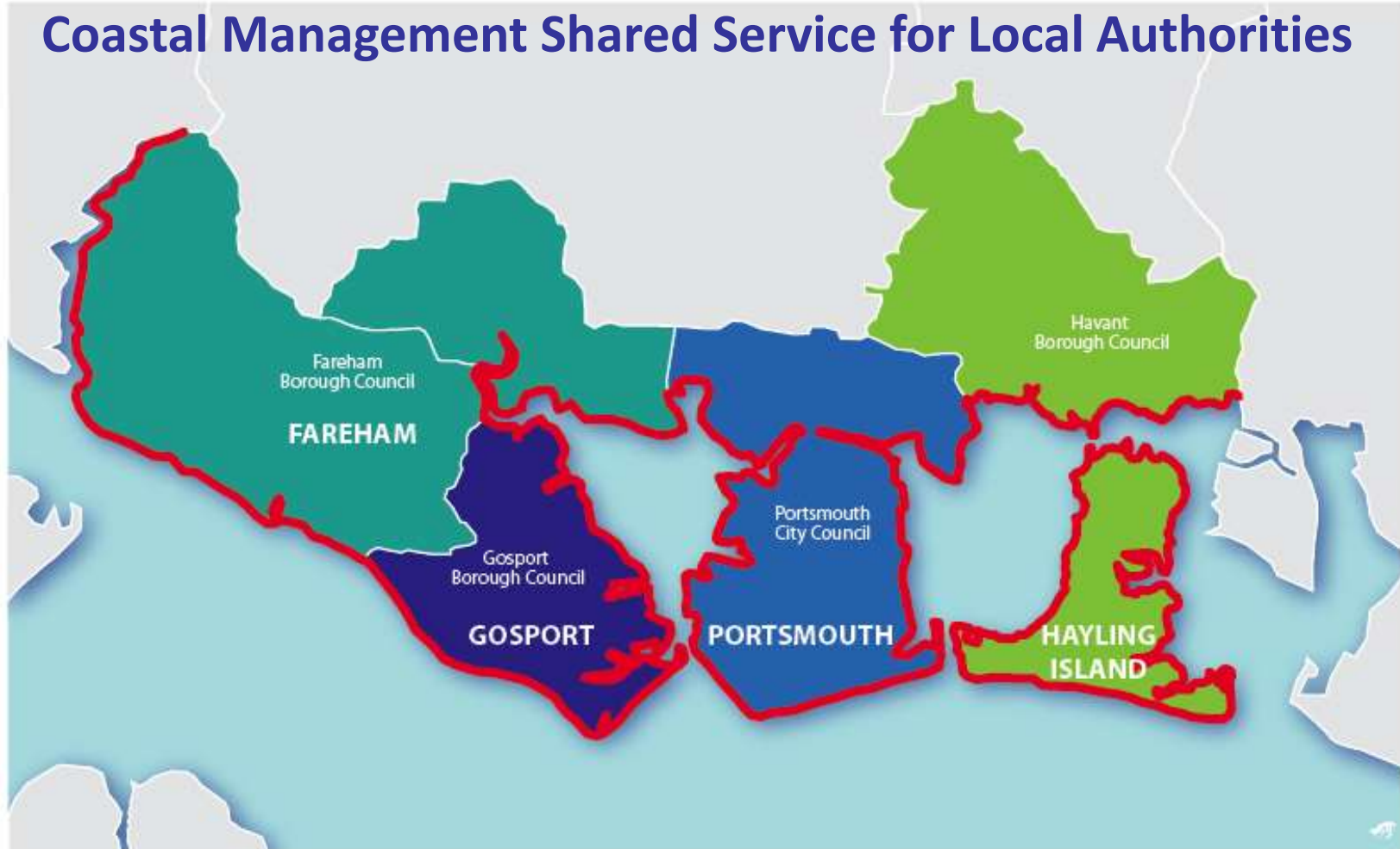

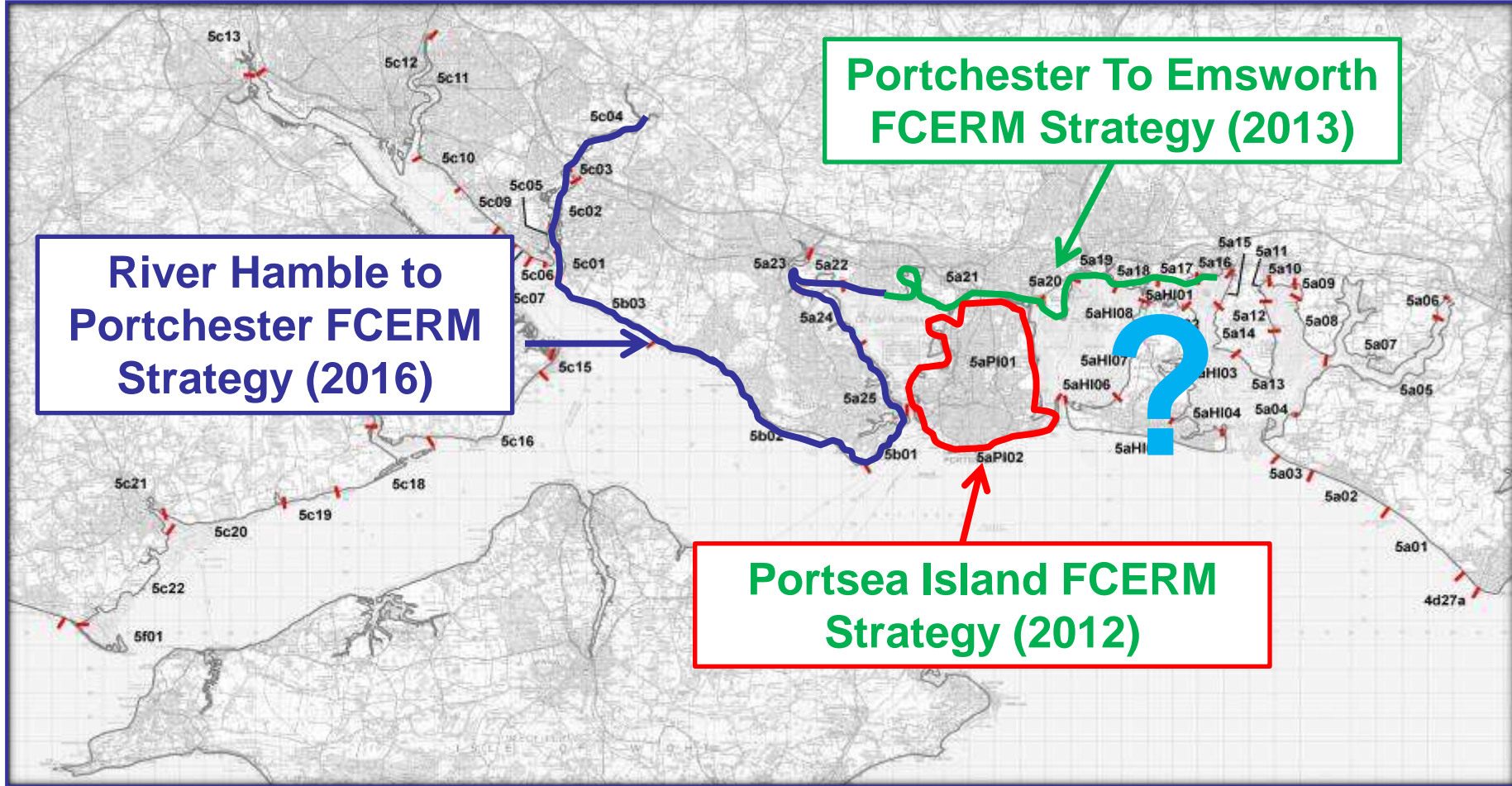

Flood Risk Management

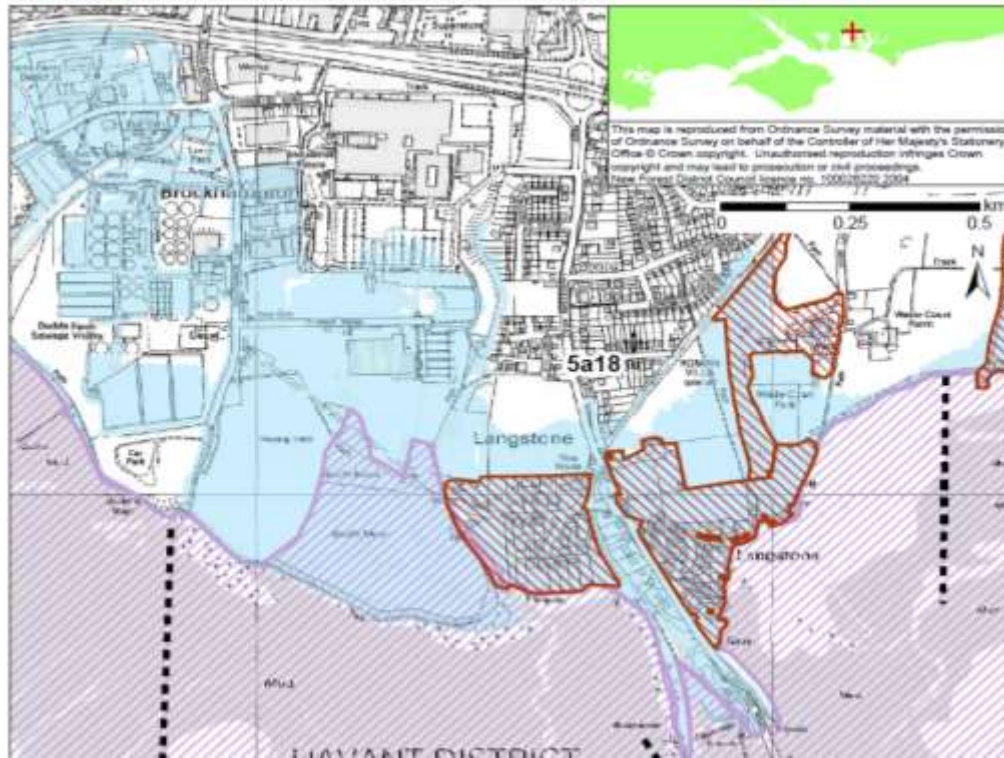
- Traditionally Environment Agency have not been able to fund due to limited risk to life and property – No guarantee
- Seeking funding – circa £500,000 for study
- Environmental enhancement opportunities
- 3 year project length if funding successful in funding bid being prepared this year (2017)

- Housing



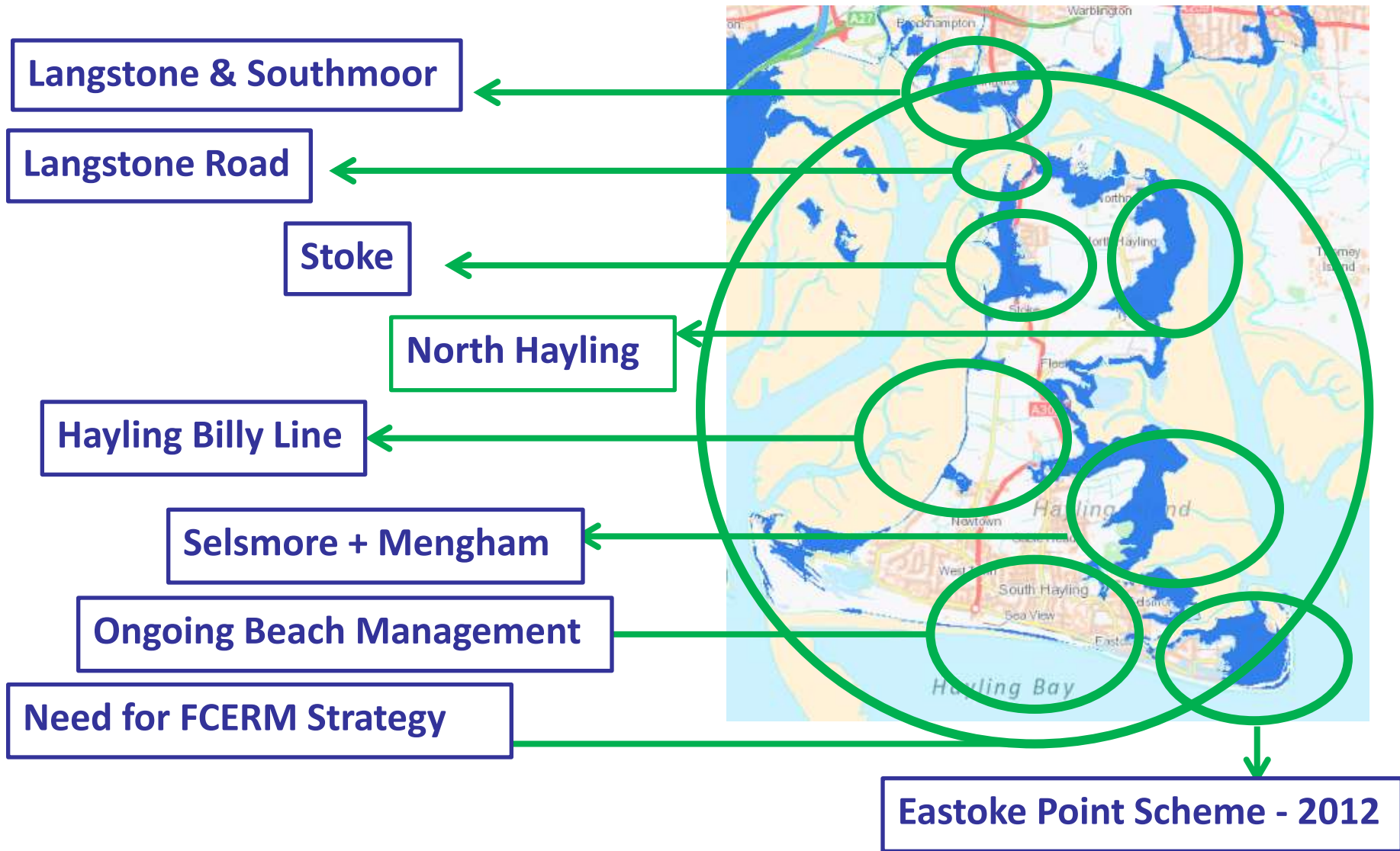
HBC community Infrastructure Levy funding - £75k



- 86 properties at risk over next 100 years
- Estimate £7.5 Million Scheme cost over 100 yrs. (Inc. 60% risk)
- Large funding shortfall
- Next steps – feasibility assessment

High level summary of flood risk

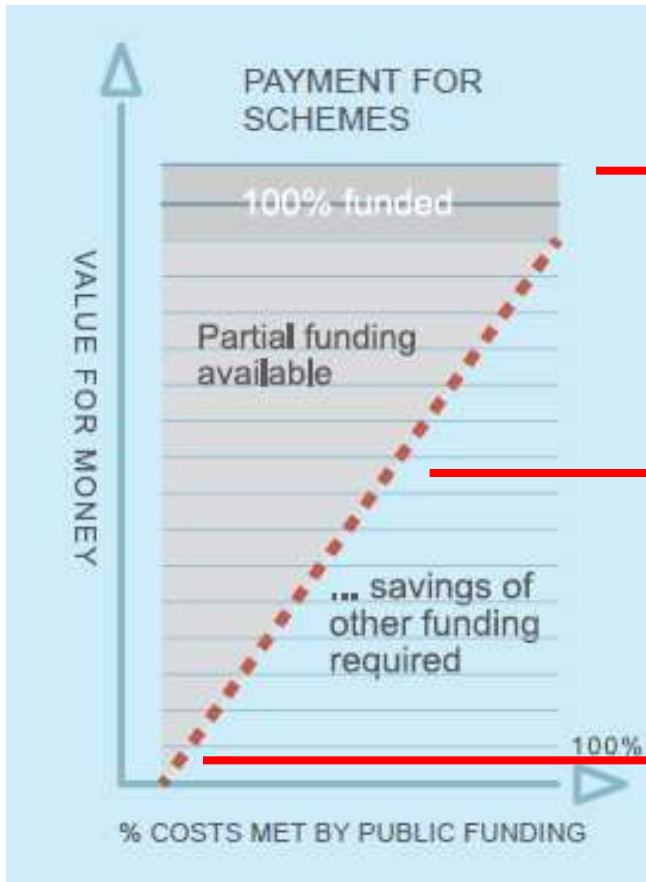
1/200 Flood Envelope present day – No defences
