


Local health profile

Population pyramid - Resident population forecast for 2013.



Source: HCC 2011 based small area population forecasts for Lower Super Output Areas. England comparator ONS mid year population estimate for 2010.

Inequalities

- CCG most deprived in Hants, though average for England, ranks 135th out of 212.
- Leigh Park most deprived area in county. Pockets of socio economic deprivation elsewhere
- 17% children in poverty, highest in Hampshire
- More older people in poverty
- Wider barriers in Havant, geographical barriers in E Hants
- Life expectancy is significantly lower than Hampshire average in more deprived areas

Patients on Hayling Island are served by 2 GP Practice the Elms and Waterside Medical Practice.

Both Practices currently have no GP vacancies and when surveyed in 2016 had the highest number of GP to patient ratio of all of the practices in the CCG area.


Homewell and Bosmere surgeries also border the north of the island



- The 2016/17 condition survey rates the condition of the building as in **good condition**.



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
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

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

Area Health Hub (Population 100-200k)

Circa 17 hubs across HIOW (most will include Level 3 services)

08:00-20:00, 7 days

Level 2A - for 200k population – radiology plus step-up beds and MIU

Level 2B- for 100k population – radiology only with access to beds in other sites

- Same day access for urgent primary care
- Community & specialist clinics, remote monitoring, minor surgery
- Prevention & wellbeing offer

Local Health Hub (Population 30k-50k)

Circa 40 hubs across HIOW (some co-located with Level 2 hubs; some virtual)

- 08:00-20:00, 5 days

- Same day access for urgent primary care
- Community and specialist clinics, remote monitoring
- Extended primary care team
- Prevention and wellbeing offer

- 08:00-18:30, 5 days

- Family medicine
- 72h access for urgent primary care needs
- Extended primary care team
- De-layered specialist support and shared care

Planning for our Local Population

The NHS (CCG's) are a statutory consultee on planning applications that are brought forward, which enables us to request funding S106 or CIL to support the development of Healthcare infrastructure.

Our input to the planning process so far:

- **September 2016** formally responded to the consultation to the draft local plan, and requested s106 contributions
- **March 2017** responded to HBC request for information regarding health infrastructure requirements for the local plan. HIHC not included.
- **April 2017** met with HBC to discuss infrastructure requirements for the Havant area.
