We are in receipt of your agenda for the next meeting of the group, and believe that if we are to have a productive meeting, then we need advance information on the content of items 3&4. A copy of the papers that will be presented to the group would suffice.

We note that Borough Council employees will be presenting these two items and we are somewhat confused since Counsellor Guest made it abundantly clear that the Borough Council are not service providers for these two issues.

It is clear that the capacity of the A3023 to provide sustainability for the Island is of paramount importance. We believed that the advisory group would establish what the maximum capacity of the route would be whilst accepting a tolerable level of congestion. This information would be used to assess the level of development that could be accommodated on the Island.

We also need to understand how and where the concept of a 'Do Nothing' evaluation of the A3023 status was determined, without knowledge or input from the Committee.

We also anticipated that the Highway Authority would indicate how they could rectify the situation if the level of congestion on the road became unacceptable.

We look forward to the Highway Authority addressing this issue.
